## 3. Discussion of strategic plan tactics for graduate education.

Strategic plan implementation is happening across campus. Dean Thein remains in each strategy to assure graduate students are well-represented in all areas of the strategic plan. She is cochairing the Student Success Implementation Team with Tanya Uden-Holman. Two key strategies include:

- More clearly define existing areas of strengths and opportunities to increase access to diverse mentors with faculty, staff, and alumni. Jen Teitle and Katherine Beydler working with Obermann Center and others on campus to scale peer-to-peer mentoring between new graduate students and more experienced graduate students. The model from University Colorado at Boulder identified benefits to both populations involved in their peer-to-peer mentoring program.
- o Promote an institutional culture of elevates the value of teaching excellence by expanding comprehensive support and professional development for teaching.
